A commitment to the service and development of youth citizenship, of their integration in society, and of the general interest.

FOR WHO – Youth from 18 to 25 years old living in the region Provence-Alpes-Côte d'Azur.

MISSIONS

Abroad missions of general interest in the solidarity domains, health, education for all, culture and hobbies, sport, environment, remembrance and citizenship, international development and humanitarian action, and urgent intervention.

PERIODS - Missions of 6-12 months

HOURS - 30 hours by week, a maximum of 48 hours divided over 6 days.

OBJECTIVES

- ✓✓ The volunteer will integrate the professional teams of the welcoming structures and will take part in all the activities already programmed according to his/her interest centers.
- ✓✓ The volunteer must benefit of an open framework allowing him/her to be a force of proposition.
- ✓✓ A tutor of the welcoming structure will follow and supervise the volunteer.

HOSTING A VOLUNTEER ALLOWS YOU TO ...

- >> Give a bigger ampler to your actions.
- >> Initiate new projects.
- Re-galvanize your network of volunteers and to advertise your actions and your values beyond your casual circles.

COMPENSATION

- ✓✓ A monthly basic compensation of 513,31 € served by the civil service agency. This compensation doesn't have the characteristic of a salary or a wage.
- ✓✓ A monthly complement of 107,58 € paid by the welcoming structure which contributes to the food costs, the transport or the housing of which the nature of attribution is defined by the structure.

LEAVES- The volunteer benefits of 2 working days leave each month.

SOCIAL PROTECTION

The volunteer is assured against risks concerning illness maternity, invalidity, death, work accidents, repatriation and professional illness relevant to the general regime of the French social security.

TRAINING SESSIONS

The volunteer receives a departure and first aid training by Une Terre Culturelle. The hosting institution organizes a 2-day "civil and citizen training".
