## THE PROJECT



Erasmus+

Your main activity will be to plan, prepare and realize a series of intercultural events, which aim to bring the experience of discovering the world to the home place of social disadvantaged people. This is to be reached through colourful, diverse programs built by one another or by separated thematic occasions, and with the help of comprehensive, creative methods like presentations, art (music, dance, film, fineart), handcraft, cooking, language, games, sport, etc.

You will make accessible your country and your culture for those from the target groups (elderly people, socially disadvantaged children, people with disabilities, gypsy students) who are not able to travel and get intercultural experiences on their own. For local people this project is a unique chance to „see the world” and also a great opportunity to break through the feeling of isolation and exclusion.

## THE LOCATION



### What you need to know about Szeged...

Located 160 km from Budapest, Szeged is a regional centre in the South Plain Region of Hungary, and the third biggest town of the country with approximately 160,000 inhabitants. It is often referred to as The City of Sunshine in Hungary, as on average, it receives the biggest number of sunlit hours a year (but don't be surprised from the snow in winter...)

Szeged offers a lot of places like museums, cinemas and pubs, and the vibrant atmosphere attracts more and more tourists every summer.

The University of Szeged is among the best in the country, and with its 30,000 students, it contributes significantly to Szeged's lovely, intercultural and youthful picture.

Talentum Foundation is a regional volunteer centre coordinating local and international volunteers, plus we organise trainings, develop other civil organisations, museum volunteering, hospital volunteering and elderly care.
