


The beginning of 2019 was full of new projects, one of which is "Open Youth Work Recognition in Armenia" project.

The overall objective of the "Open Youth Work Recognition in Armenia" project is to assist to the institutional development of the open youth work in Armenia through the advocacy of local and international experience and the improvement of public policies.

The project "Open Youth Work Recognition in Armenia" is implemented by Gyumri "Youth Initiative Centre" NGO within the framework of the subgrant of the project "Commitment to Constructive Dialogue" implemented by the consortium led by "Armenian Lawyers' Association". The project "Commitment to Constructive Dialogue" is supported by the European Union.

## “UPSHIFT Armenia” adolescent development and empowerment project



The next new project is “UPSHIFT Armenia” adolescent development and empowerment project.

On January 30 Gyumri “Youth Initiative Centre” NGO president Artur Najaryan, “Child protection” Programme Officer Artak Shaqaryan and “Health and Nutrition” programme associate Hasmik Aleksanyan from UNICEF Armenia had a meeting with Shirak Region Deputy Governor Vardan Grigoryan aiming at presentation of “UPSHIFT Armenia” adolescent development and empowerment project, which is implemented by YIC in partnership with UNICEF Armenia.

“UPSHIFT Armenia” adolescent development and empowerment project aim at empowering 12-18 years old adolescents in Armenia to be more proactive in practicing civic engagement and in advocating for their rights and positive changes at local and national levels, therefore investing in a more successful future for themselves their and their communities.

During the meeting the main information about the project was presented highlighting the initiatives and civil activism enhancement.

The deputy governor of Shirak Region greeted the initiators of the project highlighting the investment of “UPSHIFT Armenia” adolescent development and empowerment project in Shirak Region.

The project UPSHIFT Armenia contains elements of adolescents’ development, social innovations and leading approaches of entrepreneurship, aiming at the development of social innovation and entrepreneurial skills.

As a result of the meeting the parties agreed on signing a Memorandum of Understanding that will give more opportunities of successful cooperation.

## “Get a bike, get a life” Social Entrepreneurship



Among the new 2019 programs are the "Get a Bike, get a life" social entrepreneurship project.

The aim of the social entrepreneurship project “Get a bike, get a life” is to create and develop bike renting system in the second city of RA - Gyumri, as well as to provide different touristic services.

Our aim is to promote biking in Gyumri and its surroundings through providing affordable services to the locals and tourists.

On one hand the project, contributes to the improved quality of life of its direct beneficiaries - in particular young people. as well as the environmental. On the other hand, the income generated from the project will be directed towards the operations of the YIC “Youth House” centre, the beneficiaries of which are hundreds of teenagers and young people.

This sub-grant is funded by the European Union in Armenia and is implemented in cooperation with AGBU Armenia and Eurasia Partnership Foundation-Armenia in the frames of Bridge for CSOs programme.

## Erasmus+ Youth. Info Centre
