

News about "UPSHIFT Armenia" Adolescent Development and Empowerment programme

Within the framework of the "UPSHIFT Armenia" adolescent development and empowerment programme a number of memorandums have been signed with different organizations this month.

On February 1st, we and "Spitak Helsinki Group" NGO signed a Memorandum of Understanding on cooperation according to which both parties will support each other during the activities of the project in two schools in Spitak.

Next Memorandum of Understanding was signed On February 13, between Gyumri "Youth Initiative Centre" NGO and Shirak Marzpetaran, according to which the parties will support each other in promoting innovation, initiative, civic engagement, as well as educational and personal development of adolescents and young people, aged 12 to 18 in secondary and vocational educational institutions in Gyumri.





On February 22-23, mentors' training of UNICEF "UPSHIFT Armenia" programme took place, during which 5 mentors of the programme had an opportunity to get acquainted with the styles and key competencies of mentors, the features of work with adolescents, the steps to develop youth initiatives, and also they identify important methods for supporting and directing adolescents, which will help them to become skilled mentors.

Finally on February 26, the first info meeting of UNICEF "UPSHIFT Armenia" Adolescents Development and Empowerment programme took place in Shirak State Regional College.

During the info meeting, the project manager Artur Najaryan presented the programme goals, implementation stages, and the format of the project idea proposals made by youngsters.

Students also had an opportunity to participate in the training course "Initiativeness, Active Citizenship", held by Narek Tutkhalyan.
