“OPEN YOUTH WORK RECOGNITION IN ARMENIA” PROJECT



Within the framework of the “Open Youth Work Recognition in Armenia” project youth sector expert, project manager Artur Najaryan and public policy expert in youth sector Anna Yeghoyan held meetings and discussions with a number of youth representatives. The main goal of the meetings was to discuss the model of open youth work in Armenia as an effective way of working with youth, the prospects of its investment, as well as the possible forms of further cooperation.

“UPSHIFT ARMENIA” ADOLESCENT DEVELOPMENT AND EMPOWERMENT” PROGRAMME



On April 14, in the frames of UNICEF “UPSHIFT Armenia” adolescent development and empowerment programme a “Project Design” training course took place in Gyumri Technology Center.

46 adolescents from Shirak and Lori regions participated in the training.

10 teams, who passed the competition of community development youth projects, selected their mentors by lot. Until May 5 with their mentors teams will work on their projects defining the aim, objectives, actions, responsible persons, existing and required recourses.
