ABOUT US

Lasnamäe Youth Centre (Lasnamäe Noortekeskus) is in one of the biggest districts of Tallinn, Estonia. The district's population is around 118,000 people, which is mostly Russian-speaking. The youth centre operates in 2 places: an open youth centre and a smaller youth room.

Our youth center's priority is working withpeople from 13+, while the youth room works primarily for people between 7-12. The youth centre provides diverse activities inside the building and organizes lots of neighborhood events.



Our regular activities are managing an open youth room (games, ping-pong, homework, chilling), non-formal weekly clubs (DJ club, Media club, Urban club, Art club) as well as monthly events for people from 13+ (student nights, board game nights, stress free evenings). We also co-create large-scale events (summer festivals, hikes, employment events, Lego festivals) and special events (summer hike, Lego championship, employment fair).



In general the core team of our youth centre consists of 6 members – managing director, main specialist and 4 youth workers. The youth workers are in charge of specific clubs, monthly events and lead in certain projects connected to their interests and skills while the main specialist is involved in large-scale projects and communication of the youth centre. We are seeking to create a great atmosphere and empower local youngsters to take more active part in the local community, initiate activities

PROPOSED ACTIVITIES FOR THE VOLUNTEER:

- Run own weekly club based on the interest of the volunteer (e.g. yoga, language, e-sports etc).
