CONDITIONS



We have 2 spots available:

- 6 months (start in March/April 2024 to October 2024)
- 11 months (start March/April 2024 to February 2025)

In both options, it includes:

- 150€ as food money and 6€/day for pocket money (around 330€ monthly)
- Private bedroom in a shared flat
- We will ask for a caution of 10€ in your first week in Águeda, which will be returned to you at the end of the volunteering so that we guarantee the good care of the apartment.

ABOUT ÁGUEDA



Águeda is a small city in the north - center of Portugal - it has about 14000 habitants. The city is crossed by a river called Águeda, as well. The most part of its territory consists of small mountains and large valleys. The distance between Águeda and Porto is 72km and 240km from Lisbon.



Águeda is an important commercial and industrial center, located in an extremely fertile area. The gastronomical and economical region where it is inserted, known as the **Bairrada**, encompasses many of the local civil parishes and is well known for its vineyards and wine industry, as well as its suckling roasted pig (*Leitão Assado à Bairrada*).



The average annual temperature is 15.2°C and it tends to rain a bit in the winter.

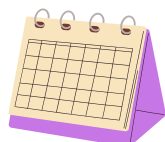

- ✓ Youngsters (preferably with fewer opportunities) between 18 and 30 years old;
- ✓ Motivated to participate in volunteer actions and activities that enable the development of skills key, experiences and learning;
- ✓ With the ability to influence the peer group and the community;
- ✓ With the ability to learn with new results and to adopt new behaviors;
- ✓ With little or no experience in volunteering activities promoted by ESC (or previous EVS);
- ✓ Empathetic and aware of the needs and challenges of communities;
- ✓ Aware of their role and to be able to participate in all phases of the volunteer activity in which they will be involved;
- ✓ Interested in participating and contributing to volunteer activities that are oriented towards priorities and values European countries promoted by Erasmus+ and the ESC.

YOU WILL NEED...

- ✓ To be registered in the Portal of the European Solidarity Corps;
- ✓ To sign the Voluntary Agreement before starting the mobility;
- ✓ To have CIGNA insurance (we will take care of it!);
- ✓ To present an ID card, CV and clean criminal record;
- ✓ To provide all the documentation we will request afterwards.

- ✓ Promote local community participation in volunteer activities;

- ✓ Promote recognition of EU opportunities.

NON FORMAL EDUCATION



All the activities that you will develop will be based on **Non Formal Education**.



It is a learning which takes place outside of a formal education and training through learning activities and with some form of learning support.

Some characteristics:

- ✓ It has a participative and learner-centred approach;
- ✓ it is carried out by learners on a voluntary basis;
- ✓ It has a holistic and process-orientated approach;
- ✓ It is closely linked to young people's needs, aspirations and interests.

MAIN ACTIVITIES OF THE PROJECT

1. Preparation and development of the Volunteer

- a. Get to Know each other and Team building activities
- b. Linguistic support via Online Linguistic Platform
- c. Implementing a personal project by volunteer's choice

2. Social and Personal reinforcement activities

- a. Psychological support
- b. Support for inclusion in the community
- c. Weekly reflection and Mentoring
- d. Promoting interculturality and solidarity via workshops and non-formal activities
- e. Individual and group reflection



3. Intercultural dialogue and diversity

- a. Promoting interculturality dialogue among youngsters at schools
- b. Developing activities at the Municipal Library with different age groups

4. Culture and social inclusion

- a. Activities at the Center of Art: Educational project and public mediation
- b. Inclusive school: curricular enrichment activities with children

5. School Holidays

- a. Activities/workshops with children at “Holidays in Motion”



6. Solidarity and volunteering

- a. Solidarity in the community with different actions (workshops, free hugs, activities, etc.)
- b. Disseminating opportunities for Youth

7. Training and quality of life

- a. Activities at the Project Águeda Amiga das Crianças (Child Friendly Cities – UNICEF)
- b. Workshops on various topics relevant to the project
- c. Activities at the Águeda Youth Center



Please take note that these are some of activities that happened in the previous years, however we are open to suggestions on different activities, as long as they are framed in the ESC and the project goals and values of the organization.

YOU WILL HAVE...



Technical support – Supervision + Weekly meeting in the hosting organization to integrate information and share learning outcomes + support of the sending organization;



Financial support – Pocket money of 5€/per day every month + Food support (150€ per month);



Trainings/Education – On-arrival and mid-term training provided by the Portuguese National Agency + workshops promoted by the hosting organization, stakeholders and volunteers;



Mentoring – A mentor outside the organization to assist you in your daily life;



OLS – Mandatory online linguistic support to learn Portuguese;



Stakeholders – organizations and institutions where you will implement activities under supervision and with support but with autonomy;



An individual room in an apartment with all the living conditions required by the Erasmus+ programme (rent, water, electricity, gas and Wi-Fi for free).

EUROPEAN SOLIDARITY CORPS



The **European Solidarity Corps** is the new European Union initiative which creates opportunities for young people to volunteer or work in projects in their own country or abroad that benefit communities and people around Europe;



The European Solidarity Corps could be a new opportunity for you to engage in a meaningful activity that could prove to be a stepping stone into employment!



After participating in this ESC project you will be entitled to receive a certificate (Youthpass) that documents your participation. You could use this when applying for jobs or further learning.

Remember to **keep your boarding tickets** (plane, metro, train). Take screenshots, if the ticket is digital. Be aware that the amount to be refunded corresponds to the maximum allowed by the distance band – see it [here](#).



Flights must always be approved by the hosting organization and the participant is responsible for searching for adequate flights to Airport Francisco Sá Carneiro in Porto (it is the closest one), respecting the mobility dates and the allocated budget provided by the Portuguese National Agency.



For the reimbursement, it is mandatory to present the travel itinerary, the original of the boarding passes and the invoice with Psientífica's VAT number **507426823**.
